A Transportation Contract **comes into** force if:



to cover the obligations deriving from the Capacity Booking process and the Transportation Service*

Financial guarantees are submitted



to cover the system's exposure to the Shipper * (Balancing Service)

Schedule for the submission of the guarantees to cover both Capacity Booking and Transportation Service



To cover the obligations deriving from the **Capacity Booking process**: **Credit Rating** at least equal to:

- **BA33** if provided by **Moody's Investor Services**
- **BBB-** if provided by **Standard & Poor's Corporation**
- **BBB** if provided by **Fitch Ratings**

or

- Guarantee whose value is equal to the **capacity charges** for transportation capacity commitments ≤ **130 days**
- **1/3 guarantee** of the capacity charges for transportation capacity committements > a **130 days**

To cover the obligations deriving from the Transportation Service for transportation capacity commitments > **130 days**:

3% Guarantee of the maximum annual capacity charges



- Non-interest bearing security deposit
- Bank guarantee, cashable at first request, issued by an Italian financial institute or Italian branch of a foreign bank
- Gas owned by the Shipper stored at the Storage Company with whom the Shipper has a contract **Credit rating,** a letter of company guarantee (implying a **reduction** by an amount equal to **3 days** of **Expected Withdrawal**)
